BOARD MEETING SUMMARY - 4 SEP 2020

Matters Decided

- The Board ratified a written resolution to purchase, subject to further approval from the from the Deputy Premier and Treasurer under the Hospital and Health Boards Act 2011, certain properties, and to authorise specific actions to give effect to those purchases.
- The Board approved the West Moreton Health Clinical Services Plan 2020-35.
- The Board noted correspondence from the Ipswich Hospital Foundation and endorsed an approach to work cooperatively with the Foundation on the future application of Ipswich Hospital car park revenues.
- The Board approved an amendment to the West Moreton Health Service Agreement with Queensland Health, to provide for additional funding to deal with the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The Board noted that the Outsourcing Clinical Services Policy was reviewed and endorsed by the Board Safety and Quality Committee at its meeting on 12 August 2020, as a key element with West Moreton Health Clinical Governance Framework; and agreed that the Outsourcing Clinical Services would sit as a management policy.
