Weber A Fracture

Dear Doctor

Your patient has recently been referred to the Ipswich Hospital Fracture clinic.

They have sustained a Weber A fracture.

Treatment:

This type of fracture is treated with weight-bearing as tolerated through a moonboot for 6 weeks.

The patient should be reviewed in 6 weeks. The moonboot may be removed at the 6-week mark. If the patient has significant stiffness or difficulty walking, a referral to physiotherapy may be necessary.

Contact sports and activities should be avoided for a total of 12 weeks.

When to repeat X-Ray:

Weber A fractures do not require repeat x-rays unless the patient is tender over the fracture site at the 6-week mark.
